

After wins Friday, The Woodlands and College Park set for clash

The Woodlands fell behind to Conroe early, but picked things up for a 45-32 victory Friday at Buddy Moorhead Stadium.

The Woodlands (7-2, 4-0) clinched at least a share of the District 13-6A title as it plays second place College Park this Thursday at Woodforest Bank Stadium.

Conroe (4-5, 2-2), which has already clinched a playoff spot, led 10-0 to start the game.

JoBarre Reed rushed for three touchdowns and an even 100 yards to lead the Highlanders. Quarterback Mabrey Mettauer rushed for two scores and threw for another. He totaled 290 yards passing 69 yards rushing.

Parker McGill was the recipient of the touchdown pass and totaled 73 yards. Tobin Miller had a team-high 105 receiving yards and Ben Ferguson had 78.

Quarterback Clayton Garlock led the Tigers with 443 passing yards and 117 rushing. He totaled three touchdowns, all of which came in the third quarter. He rushed for two yards and connected with Louis Williams III on a 70-yard score.

Wuester Cruz had field goals of 27 and 31 yards respectively.

Bryalen Thomas returned a fumble 30 yards to the end zone in the first quarter.

John Podowski and Bradley Warren each had two sacks while Martrell Harris and Reilly Payne had one apiece.
