

The Woodlands wins fourth straight

The Woodlands topped Grand Oaks 49-20 Friday night to celebrate homecoming with a District 13-6A win at Woodforest Bank Stadium.

Sophomore quarterback Mabrey Mettaufer threw for 399 yards and four touchdowns on 16 of 24 passing for the Highlanders (6-2, 3-0). He also ran for two touchdowns.

Mettauer connected with Ben Ferguson on three scoring plays and Ferguson had 190 yards on six receptions. Tobin Miller also had a touchdown catch. Parker McGill had five receptions for 107 yards.

JoBarre Reed led in rushing yards with 61 while Jason Williams had a rushing score.

Harrison DiPasquale had an interception while Tommy Kratt, Ethan Scott and Reiley Payne each picked up a sack apiece.

Grand Oaks (5-3, 0-3) has dropped three straight after a perfect record in non-district play.

Jacob Smith threw three touchdown passes and 336 yards for the Grizzlies. Freshman Quannell Farrakhan was the recipient of two of those touchdowns and he totaled 168 yards. Running back Brandon High caught the other touchdown. He had 95 receiving yards and 75 rushing.

Shane Telfer totaled a team-high 10 tackles for Grand Oaks and recovered a fumble. Drew Griffin forced the fumble.
