## Highlanders light up scoreboard again

The Woodlands scored 63 points for the second straight week at Woodforest Bank Stadium.

This time it was against the Grand Oaks Grizzlies and the defense pitched a shutout for the 63-0 District 13-6A win Friday night.

It was the first shutout by The Woodlands (4-2, 3-1) this season.

Mabrey Mettauwer threw five touchdown passes and was 15-for-24 for 317 yards. Backup Patrick Miller also had a touchdown pass and 102 yards.

Shane Walker led the receiving corps with two touchdown receptions and 142 yards on four catches. Jason Williams, Arkez Gomez, Quanell X. Farrakhan Jr. and Branson McShaffry each had one touchdown reception. Jackson Bolender had three catches for 85 yards.

Williams also had a rushing score, as did Jacoby Mitchell.

Caleb Phillips scored a touchdown on a blocked punt in the third quarter.

For the Grizzlies (3-3, 1-3), quarterback Christian Nunley threw for 127 yards and rushed for 72.

The Woodlands hosts Cleveland on Thursday night. Grand Oaks plays Oak Ridge at Woodforest Bank Stadium on Friday.
